

The breeder confirms that the animal is completely healthy at the time of handover. The animal does not have ecto- and endoparasites, it does not suffer from fungal diseases, and there are no signs of viral diseases.

The breeder guarantees that at the time of transfer, the kitten will be fully vaccinated against infectious diseases and rabies, have an internationally issued veterinary passport, transferred to independent nutrition, socially adapted and ready to move to a new place of residence.

The future owner has the right, at his own expense, to check the health of the animal in a veterinary clinic that has a state license at any specified time: before the transfer of the animal, on the day the animal is received, or within 10 (ten) days from the moment the animal is received.

In the future, claims for the state of health of the animal are accepted only if it is proved that at the time of transfer the animal was sick. If the Future Owner did not use the right given to him to check the animal for health, the Breeder will not accept further health claims, and no refund will be made.

The future owner realizes that he is taking a living being for his maintenance, for which, with all desire, a 100% guarantee for the future cannot be given. The breeder guarantees the health and quality of the kitten at the time of purchase and does not give any guarantees regarding the health and behavior of the animal in the future.
