

The cost of a British kitten

The price for a kitten depends on its CLASS (its quality, its pedigree, its color, the purpose of purchase, the sex of the animal and the wishes of the breeder itself) Classes of kittens are determined at the time of registration (not younger than 2 months):

Show class (show) - In our cattery the cost of British kittens of this class is set from \$ 4000. Cats are more expensive than cats. Kittens of this class are sold with exhibition certificates confirming the

class of the kitten. Accordingly, to determine the class of a kitten as "Show", the breeder is obliged to visit the show and get an assessment of at least 2 international experts.

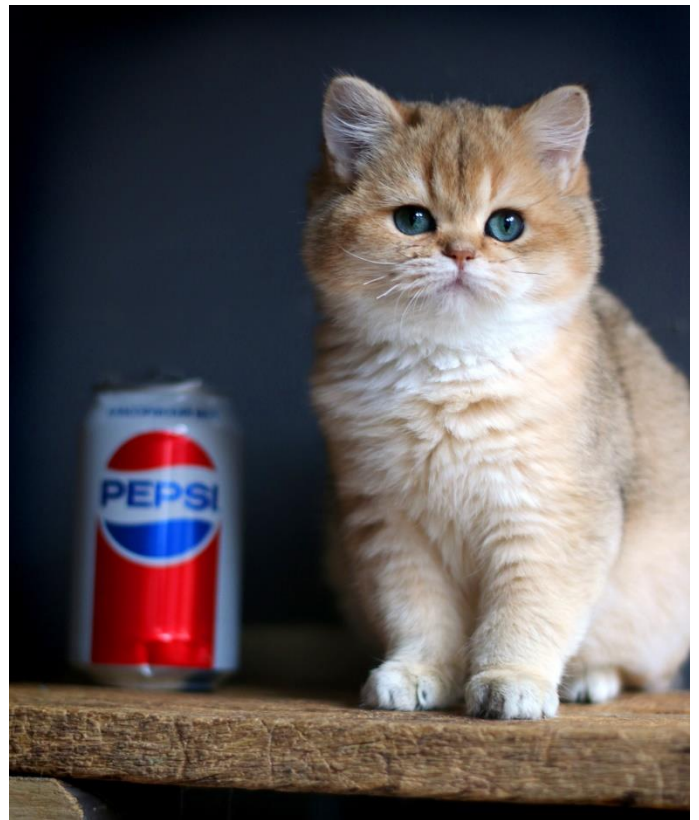
Breeding class - female only. The price for such kittens is average for the breed in a golden shaded color (ny11). In our cattery the cost of British kittens of this class ranges from \$ 2000 to \$ 3000.

Breeding class (breeding) of rare colors such as chocolate, lilac golden chinchilla ranges from \$ 5000 to \$ 8000.

Pet Home class (pet) - In our cattery the cost of British kittens of this class ranges from \$ 1000 to \$ 2000.

A pet home (domestic pet only) can be a kitten of any of the three classes.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND that animals of not only PET class, but also SHOW class can be sold for castration. The cost of SHOW - castrato can significantly differ from the cost of PET - castrate. This should be taken into account when choosing a kitten of a particular class.
